**Join the Call for Conscience: February 6 - March 31** - The Ontario Government has introduced Bill 84, *Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID) Statute Law Amendment Act*, which, at present, does not provide conscience protection for doctors and health care providers who conscientiously object to taking part in Medically Assisted Dying. A "Call for Conscience" campaign has been initiated to encourage Ontarians to write to their local MPPs asking them to protect conscience rights – in particular, to support an amendment to Bill 84 that would provide conscience protection for doctors and health care providers and create a care coordination service which protects both patients and health care workers.
