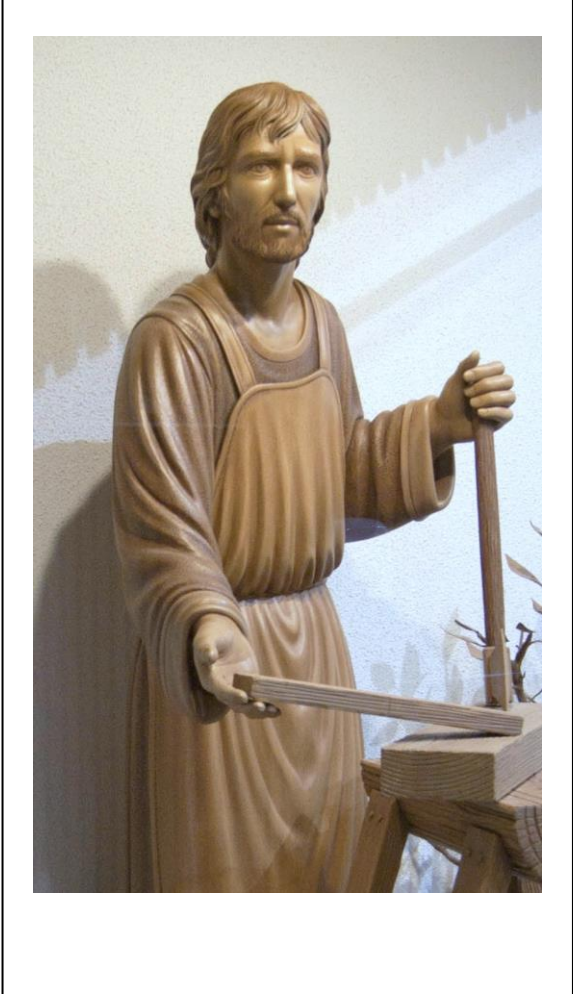

We are also looking to fill a vacancy on our **Screening Committee**. We meet several times a year to ensure all of our volunteers have up to date screening paperwork on file at the church. Training is provided.

**Rectory Bathroom Renovation:** After fifty-plus years, the upstairs bathroom in the rectory has been in need of major changes and repairs. The bathroom I refer to was 40 inches in width and 8 feet in length, not much room for moving around with a sink, toilet and shower enclosed. I have had Bernard Interiors come in to design a plan for a major renovation. Two rooms adjacent to the existing bathroom, one having a bathtub and the other being a small storage room, will now be incorporated into the plan for one large bathroom, a design for the most practicality. In order to proceed with the project, permission was needed, and has been given, from the Archdiocesan Finance Committee. We were required to obtain three estimates for the job, and, after doing that, all three of the estimates were in very close range of each other. Following a meeting with our own St. Joseph Finance Committee, it was approved to proceed with the renovation. The contract has been given to Shasta Homes Inc., who started the work on Monday, Jan. 8. The quote we received for the renovation is \$36,000 plus HST. Renovations are always noisy and messy, so during this time I have moved downstairs for sleeping accommodations. Thank you for your continued support of our beautiful church and facility here at St. Joseph. Father Charles
