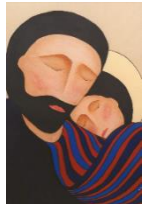

**Rev. Charles Enyinna** - is appointed Dean of the Northern Deanery. Father Charles Enyinna replaces Father Brian McNally who retired.

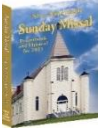
