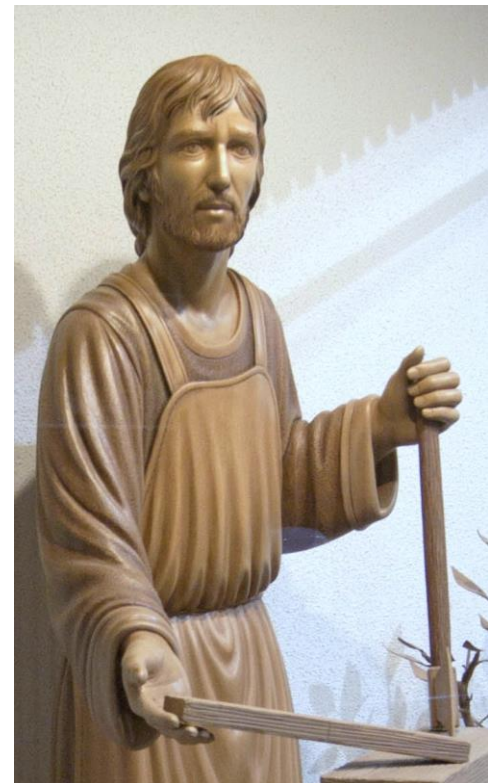

Our church is open for public Masses. We are working to provide a safe environment for all and would appreciate any volunteers who are able to assist with ushering and sanitizing after each Mass to please call the parish office. Masks must be worn during Mass and should be donned prior to entering, unless you have a breathing problem. Please enter by the main north doors and use the hand sanitizers immediately upon entering. Each person must sign the contact tracing book. Seating capacity is 30% and people not from the same household or bubble are to sit 6 feet apart. **VOLUNTEERS URGENTLY NEEDED - USHERS & CLEANERS** - If you would like to assist during Mass, ushering or cleaning, please call the parish office and leave your contact information or sign up on the sheet at the church entrance. PPE is provided. Our parish centre remains closed for public events for the time being. **Our ushering team needs some temporary fill in ushers who could be contacted to fill in occasionally when a scheduled usher can't make it. This is an as needed basis and you can volunteer for the Mass time of your choice. Please call (613)969-9506 or e-mail gusmorrissey55@gmail.com to help. Last fall we had a dedicated group of volunteers who helped in this capacity almost every weekend and many of them, for various reasons will not be able to help out going forward so if you can help even just sporadically please let us know as this is a mandatory requirement for our church to hold public Masses.**

Until further notice, the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days, such as Christmas and Easter, continues to be suspended. Anyone who is not well or uncomfortable attending a public Mass should stay at home and view live-streamed Mass. 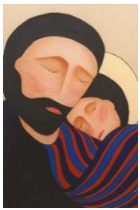
Due to current restrictions, the church is limited to 15% capacity, therefore we will be accepting up to 50 names for each weekend Mass. No exceptions. Covid protocols remain in effect. Thank you!

The parish office will be closed to the public during the duration of the “stay at home order” but we will be responding to your e-mails and phone messages for any of your needs.

April 8, 2021 Notice from the Chancery Office: On behalf of Archbishop Mulhall, I want to make you aware that the provincial government today declared a 28-day State of Emergency and issued a Stay-at-Home Order. These measures are taken in addition to the Emergency Brake Shutdown that took effect on Saturday. The Stay-at-Home Order does not impinge upon the 15% capacity limit for places of worship and therefore parish churches remain open for Sunday and Daily Mass.

The *Stay-at-Home Order* does not apply to parishioners making the trip from home to the church. (Legislation reference - EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL PROTECTION ACT STAY-AT-HOME ORDER, SCHEDULE I, 1. (1). 24.)

Please be assured we are continuing to do everything to keep you safe if you choose to attend Mass here at St. Joseph Church. Please make sure your mask covers your mouth and nose and put it on before you enter the church and use the disinfectant spray we have available at the doors, or if you prefer use your own when you enter the church. Also be sure to sign in with your name and contact info in any of the log books at the entrance before being seated. Keep at least 3 meters from other parishioners if possible. All faithful are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass during this time of Covid-19 pandemic. If you do choose to attend, please consider attending during any of the weekday Masses if you are in a position to come on those days. This would leave spaces available during the weekend Masses for those who must work during the week. **Reservations are required for all Weekend Masses until the end of April. 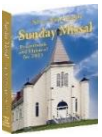
