to all families and communities affected in any way by the schools.*

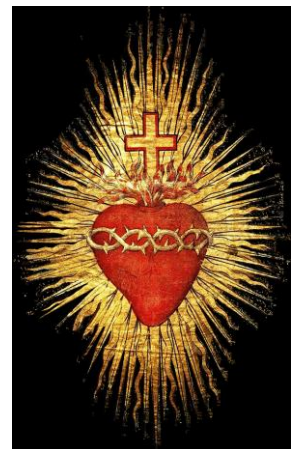
*O Creator, show us the way to healing,

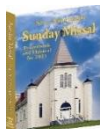
