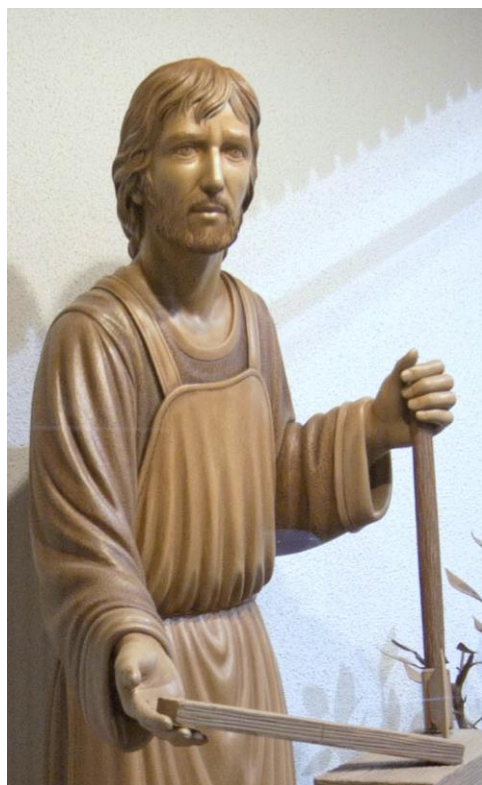

## TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME September 26, 2021

I will offer Mass here on **Thursday, September 30<sup>th</sup> at 11:30am**, praying for peace, healing and reconciliation between Indigenous Peoples and the whole of Canadian society.
